



Corner 2 Corner – Crochet Cross Flag Blanket (Graphgan)

St Georges Cross Flag, England Flag, Cornwall Flag

This document contains the printable chart details for crocheting my flag style blanket, using the standard “corner 2 corner” method of crochet, working groups of 3 chains and 3 UK treble stitches, (US double crochet stitches).

Materials:

4 x 100 gram balls Stylecraft Special DK in main colour for the background

2 x 100 gram balls Stylecraft Special DK in contrast colour for the cross

4mm crochet hook

Approximate size:

Length: 38” (96cm)

Width: 28” (71cm)

Following the corner 2 corner method of crochet, start reading the chart from the bottom right corner and work diagonally up to the upper left corner.
